Eligibility

Children of the Our Lady of Lebanon parish community in Easton, Pennsylvania are eligible to apply. The applicant must be a high school graduate entering his or her first year of college, university or vocational-technical school and may only apply once (during their senior year).

Evaluation Process

Applicants will be required to submit a complete application, which includes a one-page essay describing their education goals and career aspirations. Applications are due by June 1, 2010.

A committee has been formed to review all applications.
